JUNE MEETING: NATIONAL YOUNG EAGLES DAY

1.25 MILLION youth served is the goal now. The last I checked the program is about 35,000 short of this and on June 10 National Young Eagles day may reach the goal. EAA chapters internationally are participating by scheduling rallies on June 10.

As usual this all volunteer program needs volunteers. Lunch is now available as Subway is open at the airport.

Pilots must comply with the FAR to carry passengers including a current airman's certificate, current medical, current BFR, currency in the class of aircraft used and an airworthy aircraft. In addition there is a requirement, for insurance purposes, of \$100,000 per passenger seat of liability coverage and membership in the EAA. This gives you \$1,000,000 of umbrella liability coverage provided by the EAA. The fact that we have pilots who have come out for this event for a long time shows that they enjoy this activity. At times there are opportunities to visit with other pilots and the ground people.

Ground volunteers need only to speak and understand English and the ability to get around to qualify. You see about everyone qualifies. Duties generally are administrative, working as escorts and crowd control, and helping to set up and tear down. You also have liability insurance coverage supplied by the EAA should there be an incident. But really what is needed is the willingness to support this program. You have the opportunity to share the fun and camaraderie of other like minded persons. We do have enough fun to go around. So far indications are that there may be a shortage of these support people for this event for various reasons so please come on out. We operate from gate E at the OSU airport.
