BRENT OWENS' RV-8 PHASE 1 TESTING

As of this writing, I am 25+ hours into my 40 hour phase I testing requirement. Although I would like to be done, my professional and personal life, along with the weather have dictated otherwise. The airplane has been very cooperative, only scrubbing one sortie due to a mechanical and that was me leaving the master switch on from the previous flight - duh!

Repairs performed (partial list):

- ◆ Fixed left wing heavy rigging issue
- ◆ Mode C fixed
- ◆ Couple of minor fuel and oil leaks
- ◆ Canopy sealing issues fixed
- ◆ Calibration of various sensors

Things I have done (partial list):

- ◆ Lots of takeoffs and landings
- ◆ Climb and airspeed tests
- ◆ Stability and control testing
- ◆ Stall Testing in various configurations
- ◆ Max speed tests
- ◆ Aerobatic Testing including spins
- ◆ Formation (not part of phase I, but fun for me)
- ◆ Had a lot of FUN!!

Things I still need to do:

- ◆ CG testing, which will require me to repeat several tests from above with different CGs
- ◆ More G loading tests
